**Water Pipe Improvement Project and Traffic Information
Quincy Street, Springfield, MA**

On behalf of the Springfield Water and Sewer Commission, private contractors will continue work to replace water pipes within Quincy Street as part of this year's Infrastructure Improvements Project. This phase of construction includes Quincy Street between Hancock Street and Eastern Avenue. Construction is scheduled to take place on Wednesday, September 14th and Thursday, September 15th from 7:00AM to 4:00PM.

Due to the nature of this work, changes to traffic patterns and traffic delays are expected. Quincy Street from Hancock Street to Eastern Avenue will be closed to through traffic. Westbound traffic will be detoured onto Union Street. Eastbound traffic will be detoured onto Tyler Street. Hancock Street at the intersection of Quincy Street will be reduced to a single lane with alternating traffic flow. Traffic will be managed with posted signs and police details. Drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes when possible.

The described work is part of this year's Infrastructure Improvements Project. On behalf of the Commission, private contractors will be performing water and sewer system upgrades at multiple locations within the City of Springfield. The project consists of replacing approximately 3,700 feet of sewer main pipe and approximately 7,400 feet of water main pipe, rehabilitation of approximately 6,300 feet of sewer main pipe, and replacement or rehabilitation of approximately 50 manholes.
