Main Interceptor Rehabilitation Project and Traffic Information

Mill Street, Springfield, MA

On behalf of the Springfield Water and Sewer Commission, private contractors will rehabilitate sewer pipes within Mill Street as part of the Main Interceptor Rehabilitation Project. This phase of construction consists of inserting a liner into the interior of the existing sewer pipe to rehabilitate the pipe. Lining is scheduled to occur on Tuesday, January 3, 2017 beginning at 9:00am. Because the lining process can take 12-24 hours to complete, crews will be onsite outside of typical construction hours. The lining process is highly weather dependent, so this date may need to shift based on updated forecasts.

Due to the nature of this work, changes to traffic patterns and traffic delays are expected. There will be lane shifts and lane closures on Mill Street near and within the intersection of Locust Street and Belmont Avenue. Traffic will be managed with posted signs and police details. Drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes when possible.
