**Main Interceptor Rehabilitation Project and Traffic Information
Mill Street, Springfield, MA**

On behalf of the Springfield Water and Sewer Commission, private contractors will rehabilitate sewer pipes within Mill Street between Main Street and Locust Street as part of the Main Interceptor Rehabilitation Project. This phase of construction consists of inserting a liner into the interior of the existing sewer pipe to rehabilitate the pipe. Lining is scheduled to take place beginning at 7:00am on Monday, January 30, 2017 and continuing through Tuesday, January 31, 2017. Because the lining process can take 12-24 hours to complete, crews will be onsite outside of typical construction hours. The lining process is highly weather dependent, so these dates may need to shift based on updated forecasts.

Due to the nature of this work, changes to traffic patterns and traffic delays are expected. Traffic traveling westbound on Mill Street will be detoured onto Locust Street and Main Street. Eastbound through traffic will be maintained. Traffic will be managed with posted signs and police details. Drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes when possible.
