

TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR (WATER)

The Springfield (MA.) Water and Sewer Commission seeks a Drinking Water Treatment Plant Operator who possesses a Grade III-T Drinking Water Operator's License issued by the Massachusetts Board of Certification of Operators of Water Treatment Facilities. The candidate shall have a minimum of two years' experience in a related position and environment with knowledge of the methods, techniques, and practices of drinking water treatment. A Grade II-T may be accepted with a Grade III-T being required with one year of employment.

This position involves responsibility for operating specialized systems, machinery and equipment in the treatment of water. The individual must possess a high school diploma, a valid driver's license and have fundamental computer skills enabling access to plant operation programs. Prior SCADA experience a plus. The position may require various shiftwork including nights, weekends and holidays. The pay scale is defined by union contract and is currently under negotiation.

The Commission offers a competitive starting wage and benefits package. The finalist will undergo an employment reference check, criminal background check and a physical examination, including drug and alcohol testing.
