New Business

1. Consideration of Adoption of 29 CMR 20.10 (2) to Allow for Remote Participation for Commission Meetings: Report by Commission Counsel.

Commission Counsel Norm Guz explained that Chapter 22 of the Acts of 2022 expires on July 15. After that time, unless further legislation is passed, meetings must be held completely in-person. A provision under 29 CMR 20.10 (2) allows the Commission to adopt remote participation by Commissioners and/or the public. If adopted, at least two Commissioners would need to participate in-person, and that remote participant will have to notify the Chair and the reason for remote participation. The public can choose to participate remotely or in-person.

2. Consideration of 44th Supplemental Resolution: Report by Commission Counsel.

Atty. Guz reported that the 44th Supplemental Resolution allows the Commission to borrow \$33,692,194 from the Clean Water Trust for the nutrient removal upgrade and related improvements at the wastewater treatment facility. The note provides for 0% interest during the term of the bond anticipation note, at which time the Commission would issue a bond in order to pay off the note. This project is eligible for some loan forgiveness.
