Springfield Water and Sewer Commission Releases 2022 Water Quality Report

Annual Report Includes Water Quality Sampling Results for Springfield and Ludlow in Calendar Year 2022

The Springfield Water and Sewer Commission (Commission) released its annual Water Quality Report, covering the previous calendar year 2022. The report summarizes the results of all drinking water quality testing completed in 2022 for Springfield and Ludlow and how those results compare to state and federal drinking water quality requirements. The report also describes the Commission's primary drinking water supply source and contains other important educational information about water quality, health, source water protection, drinking water treatment, and updates on the construction of a new drinking water treatment plant.

The Commission releases the Water Quality Report, also referred to as a Consumer Confidence Report (CCR), annually in the accordance with federal and state Safe Drinking Water Act requirements, but also because the information is important and valuable to Commission customers.

Also contained in the report is information about the <u>New West Parish Filters Drinking Water Treatment</u> <u>Plant</u>, which is currently being designed to replace end-of life infrastructure, improve water quality, and meet current and future drinking water regulations. The project remains on-schedule as it reaches the 60% design milestone and construction is expected to begin in 2024.

The Commission serves 250,000 customers in the lower Pioneer Valley with safe and reliable drinking water and wastewater service. The Commission provides retail drinking water service to Springfield and Ludlow; wholesale drinking water service to Agawam, Longmeadow, and East Longmeadow; and emergency/peak service to Westfield, Southwick, West Springfield, Chicopee, and Wilbraham. The Commission provides retail wastewater service to Springfield and wholesale wastewater service to West Springfield, Agawam, Longmeadow, East Longmeadow, Wilbraham, and Ludlow.

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
