Job Description

SENIOR TECHNICIAN (Master Electrician)

The Springfield Water and Sewer Commission is seeking a Senior Technician to work out of its Operations Center in Springfield. This position works as part of the Asset Management Department and is responsible for overseeing the repair and maintenance of Commission equipment, instrumentation, and properties.

This is a full-time unionized position.

Duties include but are not limited to:

1. Supervise and participate in the installation of power supply wiring and conduit for newly installed machines and equipment such as conveyors, motors, and instrumentation.
2. Supervise the work of Commission staff and external contractors.
3. Establishes, reviews, and modifies electrical preventive maintenance tasks for electrical equipment.
4. Diagnoses malfunctioning equipment and machinery.
5. Repairs and maintains a variety of equipment including electronic, hydraulic, pneumatic, and mechanical.
6. Plans the layout of wiring and installs wiring conduit, and electrical apparatus in buildings.

The successful candidate will have excellent written and verbal communication skills; be an excellent problem-solver; be able to organize and prioritize work assignments; be able to successfully function as a member of a team; be proficient in the application of the principles of electronics including pneumatic, hydraulic, and mechanical; have exceptional attention to detail; have working knowledge of occupational hazards and safety practices and procedures; be able to read and interpret plans, diagrams, and blueprints; and, be able to effectively supervise the work of others.

Prior experience as an electrician including high voltage work is required (5 years minimum).

High school diploma is required.

Valid driver's license is required.

Valid MA Master Electrician's license is required.

This is a full-time position and the hours of work are 7:00-3:30. There is occasional overtime. Hourly rate is \$34.63 and will increase to \$35.33 on July 1, 2023.
