Introductory course for individuals with little or no drinking water experience; Prepares students for he Grade 1 Treatment and Grade 1 Distribution Water Operator Examinations, and the Very Small System (VSS) Water Operator Examination.

Intended for students with some knowledge of the drinking water process and interest in further pursuing a career as a licensed water operator. Course prepares students to sit for the Treatment 2 (T2) water treatment state licensing exam (required to work as a licensed water operator).
